2024 Graduation Informational Packet

Graduation Date and Time:

Graduation will be held at EagleBank Arena, on **Wednesday, June 5th at 7:30 p.m.** The ceremony will last about 2 hours. Traffic due to the graduation ceremony will be heavy. Please plan for this, and leave early to arrive on time.

The Graduation Ceremony will be live streamed on **Wednesday, June 5** from EagleBank Arena. A streaming link will be sent out to the community prior to the ceremony, once we have the information.

Behavior Expectations:

We need to respect and honor the rules and expectations of the county leadership. Graduation is a dignified ceremony to recognize your accomplishments and to present you to the public as enlightened citizens. Be respectful of the ceremony and the speakers. Hopefully, this will set the stage for future goals and accomplishments. Graduation is a time to be honored; celebrations should come later with family and/or at graduation parties.

Graduation Attire for Seniors:

Graduation is a time to dress, act, and behave as our best selves. Graduates and guests are expected to dress appropriately and behave respectfully. Please keep in mind the FCPS Dress Code that is listed in SR&R. **If a student needs assistance with their attire, please see your counselor; we will be happy to help.**

Dress for Graduates:

- Business attire: such as nice pants, dresses (not short), skirts (not short), blouses, polo shirts, button-up collared dress shirts, ties
- Shoes: Flat dress shoes or flat/wedge sandals recommended

Absolutely Not Allowed:

- **Jeans**
- **Shorts**
- **Sneakers**
- **Tennis shoes**
- **Flip flops**

If a student is not dressed appropriately or displays inappropriate behavior, they will be removed from the ceremony and will not be allowed to walk across the stage.

Graduation Caps:

Graduation caps should be uniform. Decorations will be allowed; they should be in good taste.

- Cap decorating: the decoration cannot be obscene/lewd, disruptive to the graduation or collide with the rights of others to be secure and let alone.
- Decoration must be flat; not three dimensional (no objects, stuffed animals, bells, flowers or any 3D object; must fit within bounds of cap and not over the edge)
- Cap cannot make noise

- No numbers other than the graduation year
- Appropriate; SR&R still applies
- If you mess up decorating your cap, you will not get another one.
- If your cap decoration is deemed inappropriate, we do not have extra caps. You will be “capless” during the ceremony.
- Appropriate Examples:
 - Thank a parent, grandparent, guardian, teacher
 - Recognize post-secondary plans (college, trade school, military)
 - Graduation Year
 - Recognize high school activities
 - Include inspirational message
- Leave blank. Decorating your cap is optional
- Not appropriate Examples:
 - Abbreviating Fordham University
 - Nothing that would embarrass anybody’s parents/grandparents
- Administration will check all caps and reserve the right to disallow anything that is not considered appropriate for the commencement ceremony; it will be our judgment.
- Decorate wisely. We do not want you or your family to be disappointed.

Celebration attire:

All students will wear the same color gowns for the graduation ceremony. School-provided and nationally recognized honor society cords and stoles are appropriate. Eagle Scout and Girl Scout Gold Awards are nationally recognized awards. These awards are permitted. Ethnic and cultural stoles are permitted.

Security:

All patrons are subject to a search prior to entry. No exceptions. EagleBank Arena currently uses CEIA OPENGATE Magnetometers to screen upon entry. There is also a clear bag policy in place for all patrons. If a guest requires a bag for parental or medical needs, the bag will be searched at entry and tagged.

Prohibited Items:

Per FCPS Graduation Guidelines, the following are prohibited at EagleBank Arena:

- Noise makers of any kind
- Helium balloons, beach balls, silly string, bubbles, and any other material which can be thrown and/or projected

Violation of these rules could result in your removal from the Eagle Bank Arena by Edison HS security even if you have not received your diploma. If you do not receive your diploma at Graduation, then you need to schedule an appointment to pick it up at Edison the following week.

Students will not be able to have cell phones or any electronic devices with them from 6:30 p.m., when they enter EagleBank Arena, to the end of the ceremony. The security team will be checking students before graduation begins and will confiscate any items that violate these rules. The only item a graduate should carry with them into Eagle Bank Arena is their car key if they must drive themselves to the event. **We are asking that families and students carpool to EagleBank Arena to alleviate parking and traffic complications.**

Name Pronunciation for Graduation:

Students will be listed in the graduation program and called their preferred name. Be sure to meet with your Counselor to ensure the pronunciation of your preferred name to be read at graduation.

Guests and Tickets:

Doors and Tickets – Tickets are not required. Seating will be first come, first served. The doors open to the public one hour prior to the start of the event. **Students must arrive by 6:00 p.m. and be seated on the EBA floor by 6:30 p.m.** Students will proceed out of the EagleBank Arena using the North Tunnel. **Parents and students should meet at the North Entrance** after the ceremony concludes. Please make exit arrangements with family prior to graduation since the EagleBank Arena will be clearing the parking lot quickly.

Dues and Obligations:

- Class fees & obligations are due now and should be paid online through MySchoolBucks.com.
- Any fees accrued after May 1st should be finalized prior to purchasing a Prom ticket if attending, or by Monday, May 6, on MySchoolBucks.com or by cash (exact change) in the Finance Office. Please note that it is advised to finalize all fees & obligations prior to May 1st, as fees will take an extensive time to finalize.
- Invoices for class fees, FCPSon Technology Fees, and testing fees were sent to all families via MySchoolBucks.com and/or e-mail at the beginning of the school year. It is your responsibility to log into MySchoolBucks.com to pay these invoices. Senior Dues are paid via the MySchoolBucks.com school store. You will not see an automatic invoice for the senior dues as it is a school store item that you must click on to pay.
- Obligations for lost textbooks or other lost/damaged school equipment must be paid by cash in the finance office prior to May 1st.

No student will be able to pick up their cap and gown or participate in the graduation ceremony if they have not rectified their financial obligations.

Summary of Financial Office Schedule for Seniors:

Up to May 20 : MySchool bucks

May 20 to May 31: Finance office by cash only (8:00 AM - 3:30 PM)

June 4: PE workroom by cash only

If you have questions about how to pay obligations (lost books, school equipment etc), fees (Technology, art class etc), or senior dues, then please check with Ms. Susan Scott in the Finance Office (703- 924-8015).

Caps & Gowns:

Caps & Gowns will be distributed to students who do not have financial obligations after the final graduation rehearsal. **If you have not ordered your cap and gown, email Ms. Ethel Olivares (LOlivares@fcps.edu) with your name, ID number, and your height. We will do the best we can to accommodate your gown size, but at this point, we cannot guarantee your exact size.**

Accessible Seating:

Eagle Bank Arena has handicap accessible parking on the grounds of the stadium. Graduates, family members, and guests may utilize the accessible parking, but all must have a DMV authorized handicap tag/pass in order to utilize the handicap parking. There is a drop-off area at the West entrance where family members may be dropped-off close to the doors of Eagle Bank Arena.

We will be providing handicap accessible seating to family members and guests during the graduation ceremony for up to two persons. If your family/guests plan to utilize the handicap accessible seating area or have any additional special needs for the ceremony, including ASL services, then you must contact Kathleen Racek (KTRacek@fcps.edu), Graduation Coordinator, ASAP, as we will need to have enough handicap and wheelchair accessible seating available and request an ASL interpreter; we must know **in writing (via email)** by **Monday, May 13, 2024**.

Transportation & Parking:

All students, families, and guests are responsible for their own transportation to the EagleBank Arena. Parking can be limited so please carpool when possible. Parking will be handled by the EagleBank Arena traffic marshals and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Photography & Videography:

Individual pictures of graduates receiving their diplomas will be taken by LifeTouch. One picture will be taken on stage receiving their diploma, and one picture will be taken off stage. The Graduation Ceremony will be recorded. Information about ordering a video download, a DVD, or a Blu-Ray will be shared as soon as we receive the information.
