
How to Access Your Session in Schoology:

PARENT ACCOUNTS IN SCHOOLOGY

A Schoology parent account gives you access to your child's classes, your child's upcoming assignments, and school, class and group announcements.

Use your SIS/ParentVue account to log in:

- 2. Enter your FCPS username and password.

Your username and password are the same email address/username as your SIS ParentVUE account.

Tech Support for Parents and Students

To support families who are working with their children during distance learning, FCPS has launched a new Parent Technology Help Desk, effective Monday, August 24. The help desk can be reached at 833-921-3277 (833-921-FCPS) and will be answered by staff members between 7:00 AM and 11:00 PM seven days a week.

Parents or guardians can call this number for basic tech support with parent accounts, help with FCPS student devices and technical assistance with other FCPS applications. If help desk staff members are unable to solve the issue, they will enter a support ticket on behalf of the parent/guardian to escalate the issue to the appropriate FCPS team. Parents who need help in a language other than English can inform the help desk staff when they call of their preferred language, and an interpreter will join in on the call.

FCPS has also set up a Parent and Student Technology Support portal at https://itweb.fcps.edu/ itsupport/ to allow older students and parents/guardians to request technology help directly. When a support request ticket is entered through the portal, it is automatically sent to the technical specialist at the appropriate site to expedite service.

RETURNING 10TH, 11TH, AND 12TH GRADERS:

- Prior to the start of school, go to any FCPS property (for example, sit in the parking lot at EHS), and connect to the Fairfax Wi-Fi.
- Restart your laptop
- Log back into your laptop and log into your Google drive.
- At home, plug in the device and turn it on. Ensure it is connected to the internet.
- Let the device sit for 30 minutes. No additional log ins or activities are required.
- Do this once a week to ensure the laptop has the latest updates.

FORMS

Although we are starting the year virtually, we still need your student's health forms. The Health Information Form (HIF) (SS/SE-71) and the Emergency Care Information form (SS/SE-3) provide valuable information regarding student health conditions. As the school year begins virtually, both these forms are required for all students for SY 2020-2021. You may electronically submit them via your FCPS 24/7 accounts within the weCare@school module.
