


Academy, DE, AP, Online and some specialized courses require the following:



Things to know about course selection

• General

- Make sure you meet the prerequisites to take the class your are interested in. These are courses a student must complete prior to entering a course.
- Students should be sure they are in school the week of 12/16/24 and on 1/9 and 1/10 to access important lessons on course selection and so they may talk to their current teachers about next years courses.
- Please make sure your student is in school during their advisory days with their counselors. See timeline for that information.
- All students must select 3 alternative elective courses.
- BALANCE, BALANCE, BALANCE. A student's workload should be balanced based on everything else they have on their plate: to include, all classes, possible virtual classes, extracurricular activities, employment, family situations, mental health concerns, etc.

• Schedule Changes

- Specific teacher requests will not be honored.
- All students will be expected to remain in their classes, including Honors, DE, IB and AP classes for the entire school year.
- Once school starts, students requests for schedule changes will be made only to correct errors.
